

Administration of Intravenous Medications Course (For Registered Nurses)

- 3. Pharmacological Knowledge of Designated Intravenous Medicines
- 4. Legal and Ethical concepts (Accountability of RN; Responsibilities of the RN during situations where patients develop complications and problems arising from administration of IV medicines)
- 5. Procedure for the Administration of Designated Intravenous Medicines
